

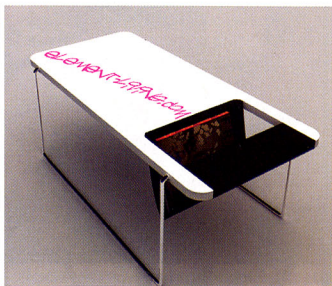


Great IDEAs

IT'S MIDNIGHT, AND THE PARTY'S just getting revved up. With each successive glass of wine, you just keep getting wittier. Memorialize that brilliance (at least until the harsh light of morning) on this coffee table by Edmonton designer Quynh Dang. The "ODd" table features

a dry-erase marker coating (available in any colour) with a leather insert that holds magazines when loosened into a v-shaped pouch or gives more table space when pulled taut. Dang's piece is one of the works in Edmonton's THAW show running from June 28 to July 6, a biannual exhib-
